### ***Daily Readings:***

Day 1: Read Matthew 28: 1-6

- The women went to the tomb to embalm Jesus’ body. They had to wait until the Sabbath was over. What did they find there?
- Note: The stone did not have to be moved for Jesus to get out. He rose from the dead—he didn’t need the angel to roll the stone away for him. Why do you think the stone had to be moved? (v. 6)
- What did the angel look like?
- What did the guards think of the whole thing?
- If you were Mary---what would you be thinking now?

Day 2: Matthew 28: 7-10

- What instructions did the angel give to the women?
- Who did the women encounter on the way to tell the disciples?
- What did they do when they saw Jesus?
- What were Jesus' instructions to the women?

Day 3: Matthew 28: 11-15

- The guards quickly told the chief priests what had happened. Their plan had failed! Jesus of Nazareth could not even be put to death! Instead of believing and marveling and worshipping Jesus, what did they do instead?

Day 4: Matthew 28:16-20.

- Back to the disciples. The other more stories of the 40 days between Jesus' resurrection and His ascension. Matthew jumps to the ascension. Read verse 16-17. What did Jesus' followers think about him now?
- Do you find it strange that some people still doubted him? Why/why not?
- Matthew 28:18. How does Jesus announce that He is Lord of Lords, King of Kings?
- Matthew 28:19-20 What is his great "commission"?
- What does that mean for YOU to do as his disciple?
- Who can you bring the good news to?
- Pray for that person today!
